Advices (1)

- Don't leave writing of your thesis on the last minute
- Don't forget about the Final State Exam
- Arrange with your supervisor regular meetings (for example, once in a week)
- Divide a complex and complicated problem into smaller and consequently easier parts

Advices (2)

- Store everything in the same place (buy a notepad, file document case etc.)
- Clean the folder on your PC up as you go along (the best choice is probably to have one folder for your Diploma thesis)
- Make a backup copy of your Diploma thesis on regular basis

Advices (3)

- Don't leave Bibliography until the last minute, make notes about used sources as you go along
- Make photos as you go along (of course if it is applicable to your Diploma thesis), consequently you will have enough pictures for the thesis and for presentation
- Buy 2 CD's in time

Advices (4)

- Language correction (it doesn't have to be professional)
- Use pdf files for printing your Diploma thesis
- Production of the hardcover for your Diploma thesis is not immediate
- Printing and bind of Diploma thesis is not immediate
- The most important parts of Diploma thesis are **Introduction**, **Conclusion** and **Abstract**
