SEMINAR 3.2 THE PROCEDURE OF DEFENSE

Introduction

- I recommend you to go and take a look on defenses of other students, if possible (defenses are normally open for public), because:
 - You will see how it looks like
 - You will pay attention to mistakes of the others, which you should avoid
 - You will see how the state exam looks like
- For each student who defends his/her thesis, only 60 minutes are reserved
- You can invite your friends to your defense if it will help you to cope with stress

Who is present at your defense

- Your supervisor
- Your reviewer (sometimes)
- The committee chairman the person who runs your defense.
- Committee members (5-6 people, some will be from TUL, some from other universities and firms)
- The committee secretary the person who writes the protocol, doesn't ask questions
- The committee administrator (is present in any form of online defense) the person who monitors the technical operation of your defense, doesn't ask questions
- Guests people attending your defense, don't ask questions

Scenarios of defense

Possible scenarios (currently)

- 1. Face-to-face (traditional defense)
- 2. You are online, the committee members are either at the same place or some of them are also online
- 3. You are attending face-to-face, but some committee members are online (mixed type)
- You will be informed in advance about the procedure of your defense (according to the epidemiologic situation and rules)
- In the case if someone is online, there will be maximal effort to imitate traditional face-to-face procedure

Face-to-face defense (1)

- 1. The secretary lets you and guests in
- 2. The secretary introduces you to the chairman and committee members
- 3. The chairman greets you and asks you to present your thesis
- 4. Your presentation (10 to 15 minutes)
- 5. Your supervisor or secretary reads your reviews with questions (if the reviewer is present, he/she reads his/her review)
- 6. You answer on questions from reviews

Face-to-face defense (2)

- 7. Committee members ask questions about the thesis (if they have any), you answer them
- 8. Final State Exam
- 9. The chairman asks you and guests to leave the room, committee discusses your defense (5 10 minutes)
- 10. Proclamation of the binary result (YES-NO)
- 11. Proclamation of marks will be provided for the group of students, once or twice per day (you'll be informed when you have to arrive)

You-are-online defense

- 1. You connect to the meeting and meet the administrator
- 2. The administrator verifies your audio, video, and other technical things (TeamViewer, phone number, ...), informs you when the defense is about to start
- 3. The secretary introduces you to the chairman and committee members
- 4. The chairman greets you and asks you to present your thesis

- 1. The secretary lets you and guests in
- 2. You sit in front of the prepared computer and connect to the meeting
- 3. The secretary introduces you to the chairman and committee members
- 4. The chairman greets you and asks you to present your thesis
